

Materials list:

Brushes: (Winton, Windsor and Newton or equivalent, cheap brushes will do when learning how to paint in oil colours)

Nylon or Soft synthetic brushes

No.2 round

Bristle or similar equivalent synthetic brushes

No.2 Flat.

No.6 Flat

No. 8 Round

No.10 Flat or Filbert

Essential oil paints:

[Note: please buy "student quality" paints, not "artist quality"

Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Alizarin Crimson,

Titanium White Ivory Black

Additional oil paints (if possible):

Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Red, Yellow Ochre,

Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna, Cobalt Blue.

Painting surfaces:

Daler Board (or similar) oil-sketching pad. At least A4 preferably A3

(Must be for oil painting).

Other Equipment:

Sketch pad, and pencils 2B, 4B

Palette knife

White Spirit (For cleaning your brushes. )

Sansodor low odour solvent (small jar)

Refined Linseed oil (small jar)

2 jam jars with lids.

A cotton rag.

A suitable palette (large plain white plate or similar will do to start with, must be flat)
